The first two days (Nov 16 & 17) are "Advanced Course of Biomedical Science," aimed at young Asian students and investigators who are interested in cell biology, especially the cellular events related to cell death, autophagy and senescence. It is an instructive program that includes introductory lectures and technical seminars on cell biology by leading scientists. Each accepted participant will give a poster presentation to other participants and some of them will be selected for short oral presentation to a panel of experts in the field. Abstracts (not required, but highly recommend for application, see below) are welcome on all types of cellular events, not limited to those mentioned above. Young scientists will surely benefit from such interaction with top researchers.
