- 1) Please wash hands and gargle your throat often and wear a mask if you have a cough or sneeze.
- 2) When you feel sick after coming back from traveling abroad, please inform the quarantine station at the airport.
- 3) If you don't feel sick when arriving in Japan from overseas, take a wait-and-see approach for two weeks by following the self-health observation sheet. If you develop symptoms such as a cough or a fever of 37.5°C during this period, visit a hospital (make an appointment by phone) before coming to the university.
- 4) All employees and students coming back from China must contact their supervisor immediately, refrain from coming to the university, and stay at home for two weeks and monitor their health condition.

Students should call Academic Affairs Division; administrative staffs should call their department; hospital staffs should call their department immediately.

Please consult your department in charge if you can't avoid coming to the university.

- 5) If you meet the following conditions, as described in both Section I and Section II below, please refrain from coming to the university and seek medical care at a hospital that has an infectious diseases department (ref. https://www.mhlw.go.jp/bunya/kenkou/kekkaku-kansenshou15/02-02-01.html).
 - I : Having a fever (> 37.5°C) and symptoms of lower respiratory illness e.g. cough or sore throat
 - II : Within 14 days of symptom onset, one of A-C (below) occurs
 - (A) Close contact (within 2m) with a laboratory-confirmed patient with novel coronavirus infection
 - (B) Travel to china
 - (C) Close contact to any person who recently traveled to china and demonstrates fever and respiratory symptoms

After receiving medical care, students should call the Academic Affairs Division and the Health Management Center; administrative staff should call their department and the Health Management Center; hospital staff should call their department and the Health Management Center immediately. If diagnosed with a coronavirus infection, your school attendance will be suspended, for a period determined by your physician, in order to prevent the spread of the infection.

6) For all TMDU supervisors: Please be aware of your student's travel destination abroad and when they will return to Japan. Once they have returned, please direct them to read this notice carefully.
