

Job Opportunity: Assistant Professor in Department of Stem Cell Regulation

Medical Research Institute (MRI) of Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU) invites applications for a faculty position (Assistant Professor) in the field of stem cell regulation.

1. Position

Assistant Professor

2. Areas of Research

The research in the Department of Stem Cell Regulation is aimed at elucidating the mechanisms governing stemness maintenance and fate control of neural stem cells and hematopoietic stem cells. We also aim to obtain a clue to tackle the problem of cancer recurrence by focusing on cancer stem cells. Particular attention is given to cell-external cues from stem cell niche and cell-intrinsic programs including epigenetic regulation and signal transduction dynamics. In this recruitment, we seek a researcher who has outstanding expertise in the research fields of cancer stem cells and their niche. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to the Department's research and education activities through promoting this line of research and participating in the education and supervision of graduate students.

3. Terms and Conditions of Employment

- Full-time position with the term of the contract, which will start on April 1, 2021, not exceeding the three-year period. Renewable based on evaluation according to the rules and regulations of TMDU, but not exceeding March 31, 2025. No further renewal possible.
- Employment trial period: 6 months from the date of employment.
- Salary will be determined by the annual salary system outlined by TMDU regulations.

Female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply for this position, as TMDU promotes gender-equality work environment. We provide career support programs for all staff that enable them to balance work and life, such as childbirth and child rearing.
