Reconsideration of established endpoints of the dental treatment

The teeth consist of 3 functional units, which are the visible crown portion, the root portion and the central pulp complex. These 3 functional units commonly play a pivotal role in preventing human body from odontogenic bacteremia. Bacteremia is a grave warning to general health. Dentists should be emphasize that the odontogenic bacteremia should be one of the worst health hazard factor. Thus, we need to reconsider the established endpoints of the dental treatment in different from previous view points.
