The clinical practice of dentistry will continue to undergo significant change in the foreseeable future. Changes anticipated in the next five to 10 years include new approaches to prevention, developments in diagnostic systems, the further development and increasing use of tooth-coloured restorative systems, a trend towards "removable free prosthodontics", the application of tissue regeneration techniques in periodontology and endodontics and advances in bone biology in orthodontics, together with stem cell and robotic surgery methodologies in oral surgery. As a modern biomedical healthcare science, dentistry will have the opportunity to be an integral element of the future development of mainstream healthcare.
