Reopening of the WAKU WAKU Hoikuen (TMDU's On-campus Nursery)

We are very glad to announce that WAKU WAKU Hoikuen (TMDU's on-campus nursery) will resume operations on April 1, 2011 (Friday). As you are likely aware, the nursery had been closed from March 15, 2011 due to the effects of the Great Tohoku-Kanto Earthquake.

Although the nursery is now open again, please note the following new conditions of use:

1. Bring drinking water

Amount to bring: 500 ml/child/day

-For infants on powdered milk/formula, please bring water for preparing milk/formula.

-For children who don't need formula, please bring tea or water.

For your information, TMDU is considering using, from April, water from a well that is available on campus. As soon as the safety of the well water is confirmed by the water quality testing, we will use the well water at the nursery.

2. Meal services

The nursery will still provide meals, but they may not be exactly as described on the previously distributed menu. Also, the nursery will use bottled water, which TMDU has stockpiled, to cook soup and rice.

3. Rolling Blackouts

At this stage, the area where TMDU is located is not subject to rolling blackouts.

4. Fees for the month of March 2011

Since the nursery was closed from March 15, the basic part of the monthly fees will be halved. The fees for February and March will be withdrawn from your account on April 27, 2011.
