

Job Opportunity: Assistant Professor Position In Department of Genomic Function and Diversity

Medical Research Institute (MRI) of the Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU) invites applications for faculty position (Assistant Professor) in the field of Genomic Function and Diversity (GFD).

1. Position

Assistant Professor

2. Areas of Research

The principal aim of GFD is to understand the functional diversity of human genome by analyzing the genetic variations through molecular biology and bioinformatics. In particular, we integrate the datasets of genome wide association studies (GWAS), expression QTL, epigenome, transcriptome, etc to dissect the mechanism of complex diseases such as immunological diseases, metabolic diseases, and cancer diseases. We seek outstanding candidates with various backgrounds in genome research, who are willing to break new ground in human disease genetics.

3. Terms and Conditions of Employment

Full-time position with a contract which will start on June 1, 2020, not exceeding three years period, renewable based on an evaluation according to the rules and regulations of TMDU twice.

Salary will be determined by the annual salary system outlined by TMDU regulations.

Female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply for this position, as TMDU promotes gender-equality work environment. We provide career support programs for all staff that enable them to balance work and life, such as childbirth and child rearing.
