Medical Research Institute invites applications from outstanding scientists for **Tenure Track Junior Faculty Position** in the area of Stem Cell Biology. The term will be for 3 years with evaluation to be qualified for Faculty position in our institute.

We seek candidates with strong research records in the field of stem cell biology or related biology areas such as cancer and ageing. Commitments to stem cell research and concerned interests in graduate education are required. Women applicants are particularly encouraged to apply. Set-up grant money is also available.

Tokyo Medical and Dental University ranks in the top 7 Japanese institutions in research funding per person and offers an exceptionally interactive environment. Many multi-disciplinary research programs including two 21st Century Center of Excellence Programs, and an interdepartmental graduate program in Medical Science and Molecular Biology facilitate collaborations among the basic science disciplines and between basic science and clinical faculty.

Review of applicants begins on 14th May 2010 (the deadline for application) and interviews will continue until the position is filled. Anticipated starting dates are flexible within a period between July to December 2010.
