## ✧ ICHIKAWA International House



The house is located in the Konodai Campus, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (Chiba Prefecture). It takes about 1 hour to the Yushima Campus by bus and JR train.

## ✧ MINAMI-GYOUTOK International House



This off-campus dormitory is located in Minami Gyotoku (Chiba Prefecture). It takes about 1 hour to the Yushima Campus by train.

### **\*\* NOTES \*\***

- Japanese government (MEXT) scholarship students will be given priority and are expected to live in a student dormitory their first year.
- All residence assignments are made on a space-available basis. We will not accept new applications if there are no vacancies.
- There is no guarantee new students will be assigned a room in these dormitories; in case they were not assigned a room, they are responsible for finding their own off-campus housing accommodation.
- Students who arrive earlier than the expected move-in date are not allowed to move into the dormitory or store belongings in their room.
- Extended families (grandparents/siblings) or friends are not permitted to live in university dormitories.
- Student's partner or family members who live together in a Couple or Family room must obtain a mid-long term visa. They are not permitted to stay in a dormitory with a short-term visa such as a Tourist.
