Qualifying Examination and Thesis/Dissertation proposal examination which is compulsory for graduation have been conducted and all students have passed the exams so far. Dissertation defense has been conducted and all two students who matriculated in 2018 have passed it. The remaining one student who matriculated in 2016 complete the JD program in December 2022. CU and TMDU have produced eight graduates through this JD program in total.
