Institute of Science Tokyo (Science Tokyo) Graduate School of Medical and Dental Sciences

Joint Degree Doctoral Program in Medical Sciences between

Institute of Science Tokyo and Mahidol University

Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU) and Tokyo Institute of Technology (Tokyo Tech) were integrated and became “Institute of Science Tokyo” (Science Tokyo) as of October 1, 2024.

1. Training Objectives

This program is designed to foster advanced medical personnel involved in the treatment of diseases in a super aging society, especially multidisciplinary treatment such as cancer treatment.

- (1) Surgeons who can advance into the field of cancer treatments
- (2) Skilled medical research scientists who can promptly respond to the needs of society; and
- (3) Leaders who can advance the medical sciences and healthcare fields in Japan, Thailand and throughout the ASEAN region

2. Admission Policy

《What We Expect of Our Students》

This program aims to foster highly skilled experts as well as global leaders who possess a wealth of knowledge in the fields of biomedical and medical sciences, especially in surgery, not only in Japan and Thailand, but also throughout Southeast Asia. Qualified applicants who meet any of the following criteria are therefore highly encouraged to apply for our program.

- (1) Eager to acquire advanced clinical ability, basic knowledge and techniques in the field of surgery, or understanding grounded in the latest research in the field of surgery.
- (2) Eager to be independent basic-clinical researchers in the fields of surgery with the capacity to take the lead in national/international clinical research projects or clinical education upon completion of this course.

《Basic Entrance Examination Policies》


Applicants are evaluated in a comprehensive manner through an oral examination and application document to assess ability to carry out scholarship and research in this program, aptitude and motivation.

3. Number of Slots Available: A few people

4. Average Time Required to Earn the Degree: 4 years

Upon successful completion of the program, students will be awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Medical Sciences.

5. Enrollment: April 1, 2026



6. Applicant Requirements

A student enrolled in this program should satisfy all the following prerequisites. He/She should be:

- (1) A medical doctor specializing in a surgical field
- (2) An applicant who has earned a GPA 3.0 or above, or who has been deemed to be qualified upon examination of his/her application by both the universities
- (3) An applicant who has earned either a TOEFL iBT score of 32 or above (for tests taken before January 21, 2026), a TOEFL iBT score of 2.5 or above (for tests taken on or after January 21, 2026), ITP score of 400 or above, or IELTS score of 3.0 or above not more than two years before the application date *.

*If official scores of the above-mentioned tests are not issued by the application date, the following steps can be taken:

- I. The applicant will be allowed to take an original English test at either MU or Science Tokyo to prove his/her English proficiency.
- II. If the result of this test is equivalent to the said requirement, the applicant's qualification will be examined with this test result and the other submitted application documents.

9. Selection Methods and Examination Subjects

The following factors will decide applicant selection for enrollment.

- (1) Application documents
- (2) Joint Interview jointly conducted by both MU and Science Tokyo

10. Date and Location of the examination

Date and location of the examination will be announced by e-mail after application is accepted.

11. Announcement of the examination result

The examination results will be sent to all the applicants by e-mail. For successful applicants, documents related to enrollment procedures will be mailed. In case the successful applicants live outside of Japan, the documents will be sent by EMS.

12. Enrollment Procedures

Enrollment procedures will be announced by e-mail after the announcement of the examination result.

*Required expenses at the time of admission

*When admission or tuition fees are revised, the new fees will apply from the date of the revision.

- (1) Enrollment fee: ¥282,000
- (2) First semester tuition fee: ¥267,900 (JPY535,800 for a full year)

13. Important notes

- (1) Applicants holding international academic history are asked to contact the JD & MPH Group at the time of application.
- (2) Enrollment may be cancelled if the particulars contained in application documents are untrue.
- (3) Handling of personal information
 - ◇ Personal information collected during the process of selecting enrollment applicants will be used only for the purposes of selecting enrollment applicants, for enrollment procedures, and to undertake tasks related to scholarships, welfare and guidance, and supervision of studies after admittance.
 - ◇ Personal information collected during the process of selecting enrollment applicants will be handled properly in accordance with Science Tokyo's rules for administering personal information and will not be shown or provided to third parties without the consent of the person concerned.

- (4) Entrance examination fee and enrollment fee, as well as documents submitted at the time of the application, will not be returned for any reason whatsoever. Before you submit your application, make copies of the originals and store them.
