

Delegation from Universitas Indonesia and the Indonesian Ministry of Health Visits Institute of Science Tokyo

On June 10, 2026, Professor Budi Haryanto, Director of the Research Center for Climate Change (RCCC), Universitas Indonesia, accompanied by Dr. Fitri Kurniasari and Ms. Eky Pramitha from RCCC, as well as Ms. Nia Kurniawati from the Indonesian Ministry of Health visited Institute of Science Tokyo. The visit was arranged through the kind introduction of Dr. Takiguchi, a Senior Advisor (Environmental Management) from Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA)

During the visit, we introduced our SATREPS project in the Kyrgyz Republic. At the meeting, participants shared information on the issue of open burning of household waste in Indonesia and exchanged views on potential future research collaboration.

About the SATREPS Project in the Kyrgyz Republic

The SATREPS project, “Development of a Satellite Data and a Regional Chemical Transport Modeling-based Air Pollution Assessment System and Formation of a Research Center for Air Pollution Studies,” is being implemented through collaboration between Japanese research institutions, including Institute of Science Tokyo as the lead institution, Kyushu University, and St. Luke’s International University, and universities, research institutes, and government agencies in the Kyrgyz Republic.

The project aims to strengthen the scientific foundation for improving air quality monitoring, conducting health impact assessments, and proposing cost-effective measures to reduce air pollution in the Kyrgyz Republic. Through these efforts, the project seeks to contribute to improved air quality and better health outcomes for residents in the Kyrgyz Republic.
