Tokyo Medical and Dental University Graduate School recruits overseas students by own expense who will study oral health sciences as part of the International Priority Graduate Programs (PGP) as follows:

1. FEATURES OF THE GRADUATE COURSE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- (1) Students will engage study and research through the medium of English.
- (2) Students have the opportunity to take the following courses:
 - [Elective Basic Courses]
 1. International Clinical Dental Training Course
 2. International Dental Alliance Internship Course
 3. International Community Dental Health Training Course
 4. International Dental Education Course
 - [Applied Elective Courses]
 1. Dental Sciences Expert Course
 2. Data Sciences Course
- (3) Students are eligible to submit a dissertation based on their research work to the Tokyo Medical and Dental University Graduate School. If the Tokyo Medical and Dental University Graduate School accepts such a dissertation as sufficient for a doctor's degree, the student will be awarded a Ph.D.

2. NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO BE ADMITTED : 8 students

4. ENROLLMENT PERIOD : October 2021

5. QUALIFICATIONS

- (1) Academic Background: either ① or ②
 - ① Applicants have completed an 18-year course of scholastic education (that ended with a curriculum that covered medicine, dentistry, pharmaceutical sciences, or veterinary sciences) in a foreign country or expects to complete such a course by September 2021
 - ② Applicants have received or expects to receive an academic degree equal to a bachelor's degree in foreign university or other institute by completing courses that are 5 years or more in length (that ended with a curriculum that covered medicine, dentistry, pharmaceutical science, or veterinary science studies) by September 2021.
- (2) Language Ability: Applicants must have sufficient knowledge and skills in English.
- (3) Arrival in Japan: Applicants must arrive in Japan from September 18th through October 14th, 2021.
 - (*1) Military personnel and military civilian employees registered on the active list are not eligible.
 - (*2) Admission will be cancelled if an applicant fails to arrive in Japan by the designated date.
 - (*3) Applicants who are expected to complete their 18-year educational course by September 2021 will lose their eligibility if they would fail to accomplish their undergraduate-level program by the period mentioned above.

6. APPLICATION PERIOD

April 5, 2021 (Monday) ~ April 9, 2021 (Friday)* *not later than this date

7. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please contact the prospective supervisor at TMDU and discuss your research and education plan with him or her before applying for this program.

Please submit all of the following documents in one package to Admission Section of Graduate School Admission Team. (Study plan (3): Form 3 is submitted by the prospective supervisor at TMDU)

- (1) Application Form (Prescribed form by the university: Form 1)

Affix, to the designated locations, photos of your upper body with nothing covering your head that are 4 cm high × 3 cm wide and have been taken within three months of the application.

- (2) Field of Study and Research Plan (Prescribed form by the university: Form 2)

- (3) Study plan to be prepared by the applicant's prospective supervisor at TMDU
(Prescribed form by the university: Form 3)

→Applicants need to contact and discuss your study plan with the prospective supervisor at TMDU and ask him or her to submit Form 3

- (4) International Application Form for graduate school admission
(Prescribed form by the university: Form 10)

- (5) Transcript and Certificate of (expected) graduation from all universities attended

- (6) Transcript and Course completion (or expected completion) certificates of graduate school Master's or Doctoral program

- (7) Thesis by which the applicant earned his/her master's degree or its equivalent (in English)(if any)

- (8) Recommendation Letter(s):

Required: A letter of reference from a department chair of the institution to which the applicant belongs.

Desired: A letter of reference from a supervisor who knows the applicant personally.

All recommendation letters should be addressed to "the President of Tokyo Medical and Dental University".

- (9) Certificate of family register or citizenship in the applicant's home country

- (10) A photocopy of your passport

- (11) Entrance exam Fee: 36,000 JPY

Applicants are responsible for paying any bank transfer charges. Please transfer entrance exam fee, remittance fee and yen exchange transaction fees in Japan by a telegraphic transfer. If you do not pay all required fees, your application may not be accepted for a lack of entrance exam fee. TMDU bank account information is as follows:

- An English translation is needed if an official certificate is in another language.

Acceptance to the Graduate School is determined solely by a review of the application documents submitted.

11. OTHERS:

- (1) Changes to the contents of an application (including the change of the department you want to enter) are not allowed after the application package has been submitted.
- (2) If the name shown on a certificate in your application package differs from that shown on your application form, be sure to attach proof of your change of name.
- (3) Office hours: 9:00- 12:00; 13:00- 17:00, Monday–Friday
- (4) If any difference is found between facts and matters as described in your application documents, your enrollment may be canceled.
- (5) Handling of personal information.
 1. Personal information is collected in the application process and selection process, and may be used to carry out health guidance or education after admission. It will not be used for any other the purposes.
 2. Regarding personal information collected in the process of selecting entrants, the “National University Corporation Tokyo Medical and Dental University Personal Information Management Rules” will be followed and TMDU will not disclose any such information to third parties without consent of the applicant.
- (6) Applicants who are expected to complete their 18-year educational course by September 2021 will lose their eligibility if they would fail to accomplish their undergraduate-level program by the period mentioned above.
- (7) Students are encouraged to apply for scholarships other than the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho) Scholarship.
- (8) Tuition may be exempted based on student's academic performance and financial status.
- (9) Students are advised to acquire some knowledge of Japanese culture, customs, weather, and the university system before coming to Japan. The use of English is given priority in study and research; however, some ability to speak Japanese will be needed right away to conduct your daily affairs in Japan. It is strongly advised, therefore, that international students acquire some level of Japanese language proficiency before starting at the university.
