





① First Trip to Thailand since the COVID-19 Pandemic

A lthough this newsletter is focused on activities based in Thailand, the COVID-19 pandemic has made mutual exchange visits impossible. Despite this, we have continued to accept new students to the Joint Degree Program (JDP) with Chulalongkorn University Faculty of Dentistry. We are grateful for the efforts of everyone involved in this endeavor. As the pandemic enters its third year, however, such visits are finally becoming a little less complicated. In the first instance, we were able to dispatch one fourth-year medical student to Chulalongkorn University for a project semester starting in June. In addition, three students from Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University, who are in the first phase of the JDP, will come to Japan in October to receive training in the Department of Surgery at TMDU.

As these interactions progress, at times email exchanges and online meetings may not suffice to adequately convey pertinent information, or there could be lags in response. To address this, Professor Keiichi Akita visited Chulalongkorn University Faculties of Medicine and Dentistry, Siriraj Hospital and Ramathibodi Hospital of Mahidol University and HRH Princess Chulabhorn Royal Academy College of Medical Science over a two-day period spanning August 9–11, to exchange views on the future of the JDP and student exchange.

While the evolution of online technology has made international exchange much easier and more accessible, the benefits of face-to-face meetings are still immeasurable. In the future, we will strive to return to the in-person exchanges we once enjoyed, and find ways to improve them even further.

On Friday September 2, 2022, Professor Prasit, Mahidol University Faculty of Medicine, Siriraj Hospital Dean, and his delegation of nine members visited TMDU.

In the morning, three Mahidol University JDP professors visited the University for a meeting on the Mahidol JDP with JDP faculty members of TMDU. They were also able to meet with faculty members in charge of JDP clinical training and research activities and to share information about incoming students.

In the afternoon, Prof. Prasit, MU Faculty of Medicine Dean, Prof. Apicaht, incoming MU Faculty of Medicine Dean, and their delegation paid a courtesy visit to TMDU President, Prof. Yujiro Tanaka. President Tanaka shared memories of his visit to Thailand as a member of the board of trustees of TMDU for the signing of the JDP agreement with Mahidol University. TMDU Executive Directors, the Faculty of Medicine Dean, and other key personnel joined the session to discuss the personal relationships fostered through exchange between the two universities and enthusiastically discuss future collaboration. ■
