



Immigration Procedures 1

- At the airport
 - Residence Card
 - * Have to carry always
- City hall
 - Notification of moving in
 - * Within 14 days
 - National Health Insurance (NHI)
 - * Mandatory
 - * 70% of the expense will be covered

Residence Card




NHI Card
