Essential Expertise for Clinical Dentistry (EECD) 7 (AY2021)

Clinical Dentistry

This course offers you up-to-date dental clinical knowledge and techniques that are often publicized in journals or books. Experts in various fields/team EECD will provide hands-on sessions during summer and conduct case-based discussions (treatment planning session) in winter. EECD aims at not only 1) updating participants' dental knowledge but also 2) developing and brushing up clinical techniques (hands on sessions). You will have the chance to actually engage in discussions with your peers and join hands on clinical focused sessions.

Overview

- You should join all assigned sessions.
- Each hands-on session is 180 minutes (except for the optional session (orthodontics)).
- Treatment planning session is 90 minutes via a web conferencing system.

In this course, you will:

- Learn dental knowledge and perspectives through interactive sessions.
- Practice clinical techniques and skills in the hands on sessions.

After this course, you will be able to:

- Have new dental knowledge and new approaches for future treatments.
- Consider your clinical cases from a critical perspective and acquire new approaches for your treatments.
- Use skills for clinical procedures.
