

International Exchange/Visiting Students Frequently Asked Questions

1) I cannot prepare all the required documents by the deadline.

Please contact the Yushima International Exchange Support Group as soon as possible, including your assigned Entry Number.

2) We will not be able to complete the selection process for the students to be dispatched by the deadline for the Application Form.

Please contact the Yushima International Exchange Support Group as soon as possible, including your assigned Entry Number.

* However, due to the internal administrative schedule, there may be cases where we are unable to accept your application.

3) Do I need to pay the full monthly tuition fee even if the stay is less than one month?

Yes, the tuition fee cannot be prorated. Additionally, if the stay spans multiple months, you will need to pay the tuition fee for each month.

* Please note that, for example, if the stay is from January 31 to March 1, which spans three months, you will be required to pay the tuition fee for three months (29,700 × 3).

4) If I am unable to participate in the semester I initially applied for, can I reapply for the next semester?

Yes, you can. The results of acceptance or non-acceptance for each semester will be announced during the Letter of Acceptance issuance period listed in the Application Schedule on our website. If, unfortunately, your application is not accepted, you may reapply once the Entry period for the next semester begins.

5) Is there any dress code that participants are expected to follow?

Students are requested to wear either white coats or scrubs during clinical hours. Please also ensure to wear a mask. Kindly note the following guidelines:

- Please do not wear: dirty white coats, sheer blouses or shirts, vivid colored clothes, short skirts, shorts, or other unprofessional attire.
- No accessories (jewelry, wedding bands, etc.), no perfume or cologne. No sandals, high heels, or boots.

6) What language requirements apply to this program?

Students are required to have sufficient proficiency in either English or Japanese to communicate effectively.

7) Is there an orientation or briefing session?

A brief orientation will be conducted by the administrative office on the first day of the placement.
