APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Educational Background/Research Experience: Only those who have dental or medical licensure or dental school graduates can join this course.
- 2. Communication Ability: Applicants must have sufficient general knowledge of the subject matter and adequate communication skills in English so as to be able to participate in discussion.

A complete set of application documents must be submitted to the TMDU Institute of Global Affairs by e-mail (kokusai.adm@tmd.ac.jp) and be received by January 10, 2022, Japan standard time.

- (1) TMDU will announce the participant list after screening the submitted application documents.
- (2) Announcement of Acceptance will be emailed to you by the middle of January 2022. *If you are chosen, an invitation letter and other related documents will be sent at the same time.
