
#### INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

- International Office is the university division dedicated to support the internationalization goals of the university, and to handle international mobility involving our and international students and faculty members.
- The goal is to assist the international students and scholars handle their academic-related matters at University of Indonesia and to bridge UI members with overseas universities.



#### STUDENT EXCHANGE

- As an implementation of the cooperation between UI and partner universities
- Students are allowed to study in partner universities for 1 or 2 semesters
- Students who are interested must :
  - Fulfilled the qualification of UI and partner universities
  - Apply through UI's International office
  - Pay their tuition fees only to UI and exempted from the tuition fees in partner university
  - credits of the courses are transferrable to University of Indonesia based on approval





- Currently credit of study subjects are not transferrable yet, due to the differences in curriculum of each faculty of dentistry in partner universities
- Currently we have students studying full course of dentistry from Malaysia and Korea (course are taught in bahasa Indonesia)
- Accepts short term student exchange to observe how we study dentistry in Indonesia, and experiencing some specific cases
































- 2. By connecting the letters M and D, the logo mark implies fusion of Medicine and Dentistry.














#### TMDU International Summer Program (Med & Dent)

# ANESTHESIOLOGY AND CLINICAL PHYSIOLOGY

- Places we visited: Outpatient Clinic, Recovery Room, and Operation Room
- Dentists perform general anesthesia → only for maxillofacial cases
- We were shown patients under treatment

### MAXILLOFACIAL PROSTHODONTICS

### The treatments are:

- >Intraorally prosthesis with obturatort to cover the defect.

- ➤ Biting evaluation by chewing gums
























# MOLECULAR CRANIOFACIAL EMBRYOLOGY

- OMS works together with Anesthesiology department in doing surgery




