Scope of “5th International Symposium on Nanomedicine (ISNM2012)”

The combination of top-down and bottom-up nanotechnologies started a real revolution in science & technology. As a result, we can expect these new technologies to be used to develop novel devices for treatment of cancer and many other intractable diseases.

The aims of this symposium are (1) to provide a platform on which to discuss the future prospects for these science-technologies and construct an international human network in the fields of Nano-Bio-Medicine and (2) to incubate excellent young generation researchers in these fields utilizing this network. Concerning these aims, we especially consider the importance of Asian network, and invite several speakers in the relating fields from these countries. The key words of the 5th symposium are cancer and epigenetics , nanomedicine and microfluidics, ncRNA, molecular imaging, drug delivery, regenerative medicine, neurodegenerative disease and other nanomedicine topics.
